About the model

Opening the Future funds BPC-free open access book publishing while also broadening your own collection through an affordable subscription to closed content.

We're reshaping how knowledge dissemination is funded and accessed, by leveraging the collective contributions of academic libraries worldwide. Your *Opening the Future* membership funds a press to publish new OA monographs, while your library bene'ts from access to closed content, and no single institution bears a disproportionate burden. For a modest annual fee your library gets DRM-free, unlimited access to a closed-access selection of a publisher's backlist, with perpetual access after three years. The membership revenue is used by the publisher solely to produce new OA monographs, moving towards an affordable, sustainable model for academic publishing and creating a collection of OA books that are open for the world.

Through OtF, collections can grow at vastly reduced fees and funding future OA books demonstrably costs a fraction of closed monographs. Be part of something special. Join over 80 Universities around the world already committed to *Opening the Future*.

The model was developed and implemented at CEU Press in partnership with Copim.
